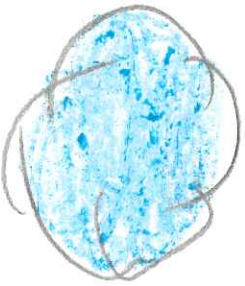
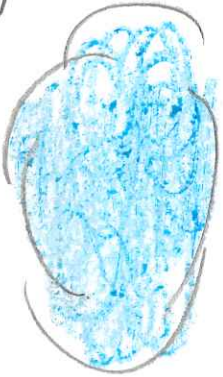
Dear friends
