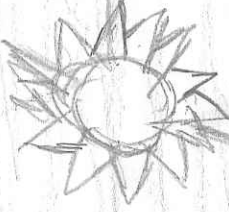
I know that I'm a kid and I

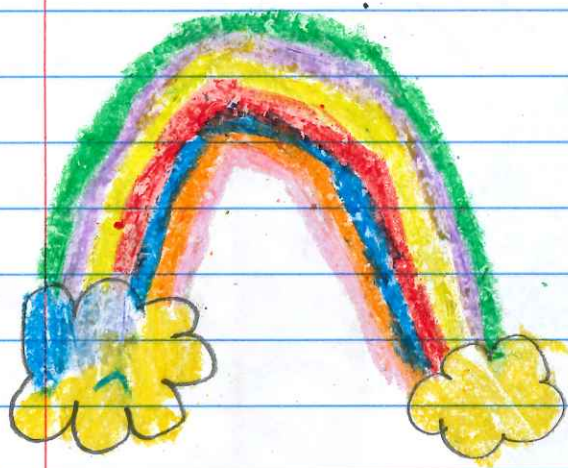

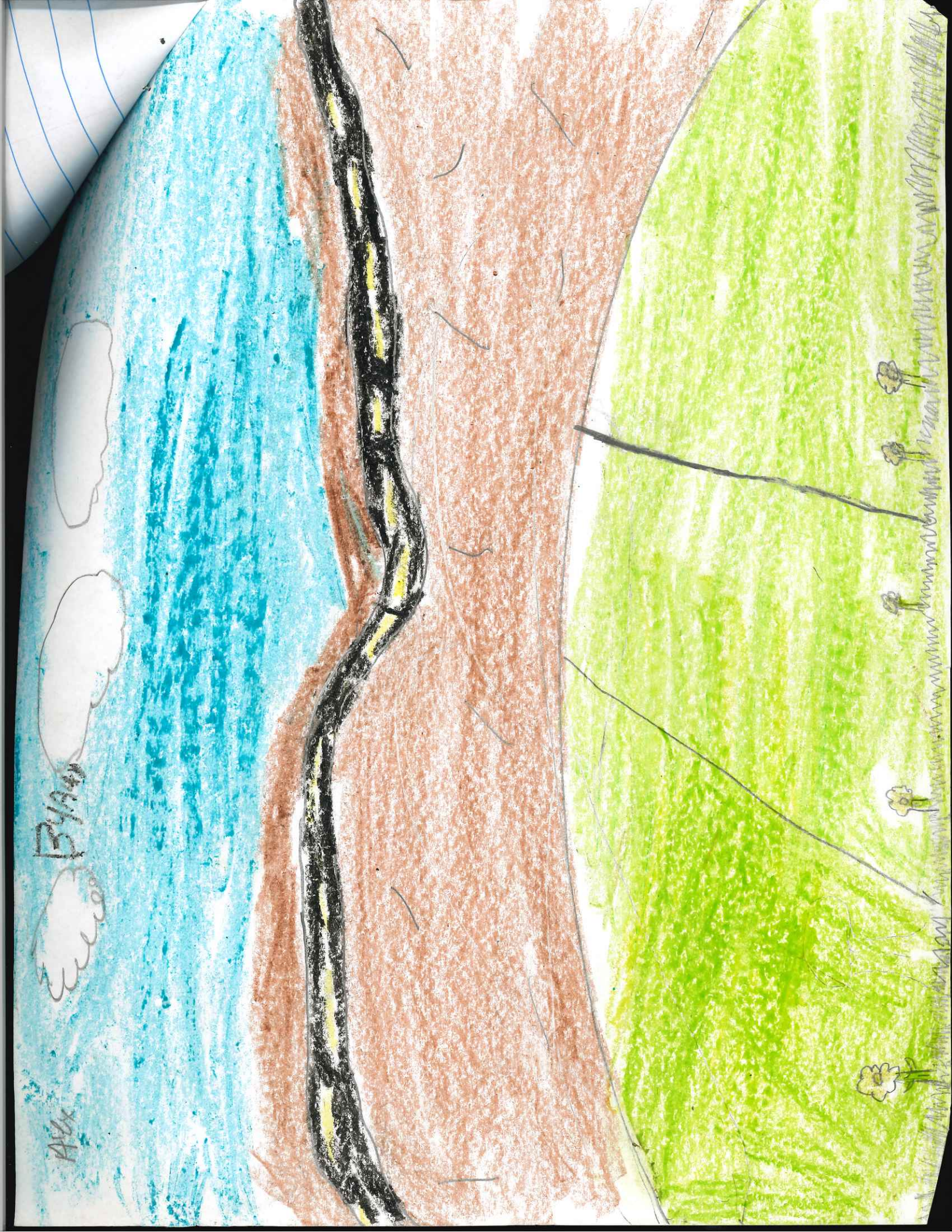
