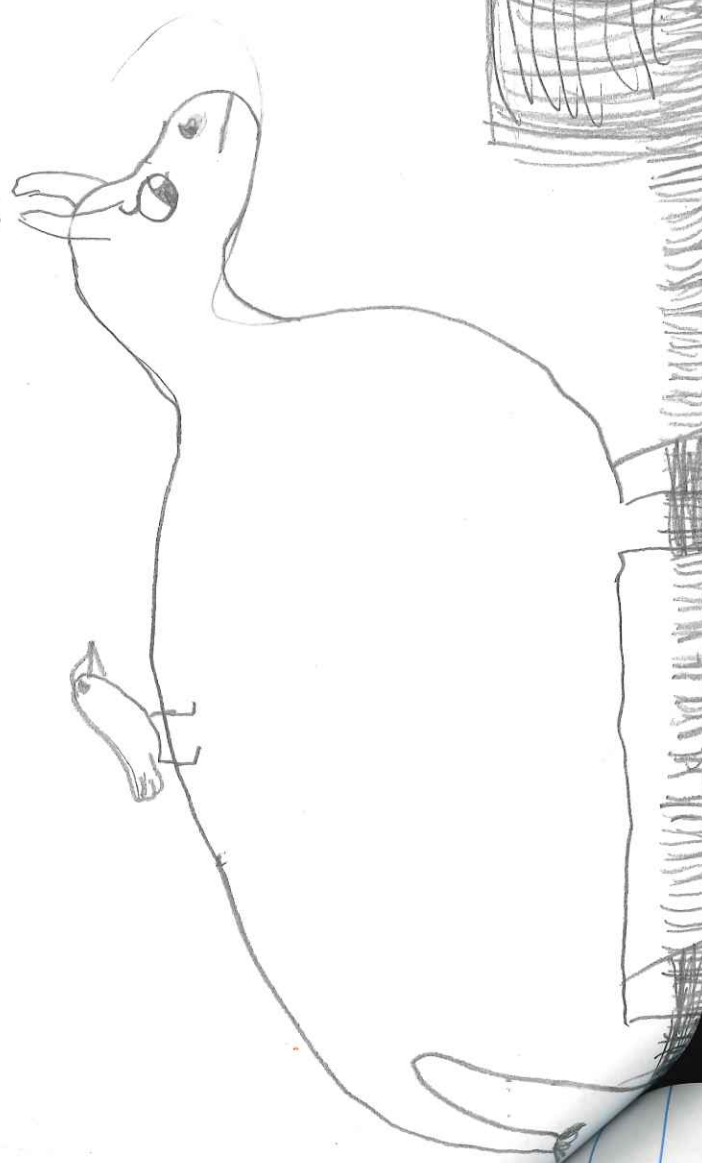
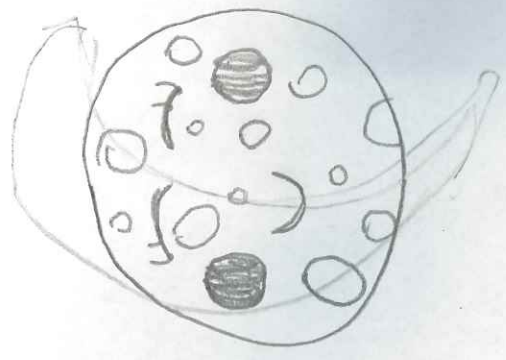
Dear Ashland citizens,

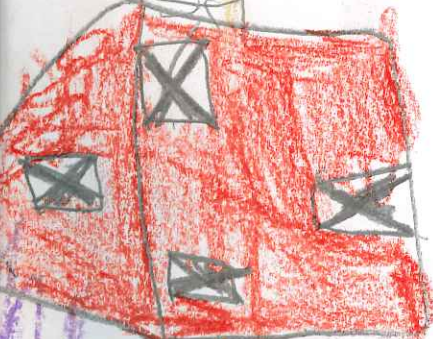
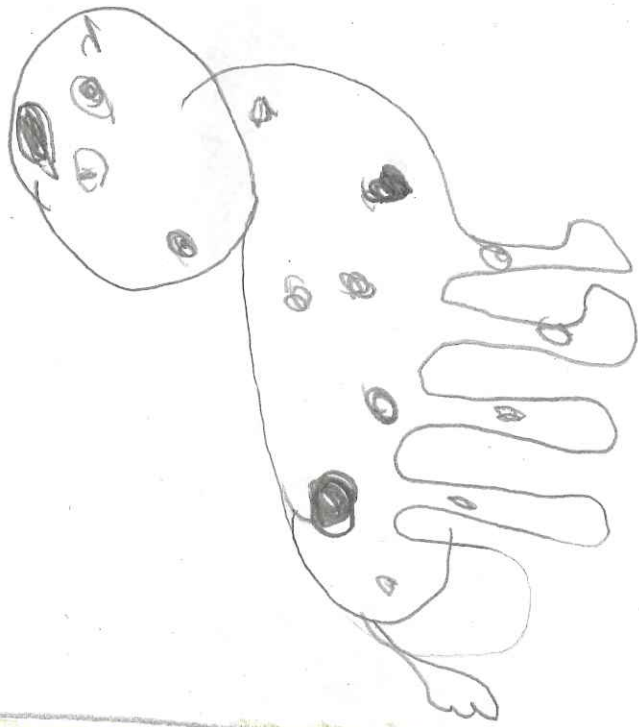
